

Democrats' Strategies and Needed Republican Counter Strategies

I am writing this because I believe the US Constitution and its rule of law are essential to the past and continued prosperity of the US. However, at present, it appears that the Democratic Party has been taken over by people who are hostile to the US Constitution and laws that support it. Thus, it must be defeated before it can do irreparable damage. Unfortunately, the Democratic Party has a large advantage over Republicans, even though it pursues policies that are largely politically unpopular. The reason is that they have a strong ground game, and they pursue Marxist organization strategies.

They have over 30,000 “Organizing for America” groups that were established under Obama's leadership after his presidency ended. Those groups seem to be structured like Marxist groups were organized early on in Russia. They seem to be separate cells that have leaders who can activate the cell's members according to centrally dictated commands. Members of each group may know each other, but most do not know the central command source. That way, the whole organizational structure and its leaders cannot be exposed easily.

In the contemporary US, many of the community interest groups may be organized along the lines of special interests. Communists have long used a policy of organizing “useful dupes” to further their cause. Such groups can be organized to pursue political policies that have a strong emotional appeal to a particular group. Various groups may be organized according to their members' political leanings, special economic interests, sexual proclivities, environmental feelings, global warming fears, animal rights concerns, etc. In short, many “progressive” groups can be organized as special interest groups subject to Democrats' influence and control.

The appropriate cells can be activated to achieve certain goals. For instance, when Arizona Senator Sinema did not vote the way the Democrats wanted in Congress, Arizona groups were organized that harassed her at the airport, and she had a Democrat Party sponsored primary challenge that deprived her of the Democratic nomination for her next election. Even now, Democrats in Congress who vote the wrong way are threatened with being removed by primary competition.

Also, the Democrats can help organize supportive cells and take credit for doing so whenever a special interest group demonstrates. In addition, they can organize mass turnouts and identify and energize their potential voters by organizing “No Kings” demonstrations, etc. Because of their focused activity, Democrats can control votes that far exceed their numbers. Republicans have no counterpart.

POSSIBLE REPUBLICAN COUNTER STRATEGIES

Republicans need to do two things. First, they need to educate the general public regarding the deep influence Marxists and their “cultural Marxist” or “woke” derivatives have on US policies. They need to make the public aware that The Communist Manifesto, written by Marx and Engels, called for Communists and Marxists to take over and influence public media and education. Because they have done so to a great degree, it is hard to get true facts from many sources of so-called unbiased information. This process has been aggravated by the fact that many of the Democratic Party leaders (Obama, Bernie Sanders, Hillary Clinton, and others) have been heavily influenced by Saul Alinsky, who wrote “Rules for Radicals”, and has developed an extensive “community organizing” network and educational machine (centralized in Chicago).

Major principles of Marxist policies need to be exposed, so people will recognize their impact on “Wokeness” and the Democratic Party's strategies. In general, Marxism wants to make people dependent upon the state, which will allocate wealth (income) according to people's “needs,” rather than according to their personal performance. It also considers religion to be “the opiate of the masses” and essentially wants to do away with religion, because it deludes people and makes them less willing to do the will of the state, since their allegiance is to a higher power. Thus, the current Democratic Party seems to be openly hostile to Jews and, during the Biden administration, was often hostile to Catholics and other devout religious Christians. That hostility seems to have continued, in part because religious people do not give their primary allegiance to the “state.” For similar reasons, Marxists seem

to want to undermine the family and parents' influence over their own children. If the children are strongly responsible for family loyalties and parental oversight, that weakens the ability of the Marxists' followers to influence the children and their values in any way they may wish. Among other things, by encouraging early sexual awareness and activity, Marxists may be able to influence children's emotional states and reactions before they acquire maturity and discretion. Immature and overly emotional people are more likely to become "useful idiots" who support Democrats' policies. Finally, it should be noted that Marxists believe that their policies should be spread worldwide (like a religion) since they believe their policies will make the world a better place if everyone follows them. Thus, they tend to support "globalist" policies and organizations and downgrade the importance of national patriotism. They particularly dislike the US since it favors policies that reward individual effort and success over policies that emphasize that people should be subservient to the will of the "collective," state, or international organization (such as the UN).

In addition to its "cultural Marxist" orientation and policies, the Democratic Party has another Achilles heel in that it is highly supportive of illegal aliens and criminal activities. It has sponsored many attorney general candidates who do not prosecute criminal activities, and organizations that support defunding the police and other law-enforcing authorities. In addition, it has supported illegal immigration, voting by non-citizens, and it has opposed attempts to enforce immigration and citizenship voting requirements. All that is done in the interest of generating more voters who will support the Democratic Party—even if their votes are illegal or they are felons.

The preceding comments give clues to the groups that should be logically opposed to Marxism and the current Democratic Party trends. Those people and groups need to be organized, so the Republicans will also have a "ground game" that can be deployed for political purposes. Such groups would include religious groups of all types, but especially including Christians and Jews, due to their emphasis on individual behavior as a prerequisite for a good life and/or afterlife. It also would include groups concerned with the importance of the family and with the importance of parents rather than the "state" in influencing their children's lives and values. Entrepreneurial groups and small business groups that work hard to make a living and believe that they should be entitled to keep most of what they earn and not be buried under multitudinous costly regulations imposed by the "state" should also be organized. Patriotic groups, veterans groups, and other groups that believe in the significance and importance of the US Constitution and the US form of government, with emphasis on the rights of individuals, as opposed to the unfettered powers of the state, should also be supportive of Republican efforts. Finally, civic groups that support law and order and law-enforcement groups of all types, as well as patriot groups, all should be supportive of Republican activities and votes designed to rein in the Democrats' attempt to disrupt civil order and to obtain votes from people who are not entitled to vote in US elections.

Unfortunately, the Democrats have effectively organized people who expect to benefit from government jobs, grants, or political favors that they promise to give to special groups. Also, many Democratic supporters are employed by the government or on government doles, so their job responsibilities may be light relative to the benefits they expect to receive from political activity. Conversely, many potential Republican supporters have jobs and families and other interests that may prevent them from giving their whole-hearted support to Republican political endeavors. Republicans need to become more active in encouraging people in general to see that they have a vested interest in opposing the Democrats' endeavors; thus, they need to interact with all the groups and people cited above who oppose the Democrats' "cultural Marxist" policies and policies that support illegal activity. They also need to encourage all those people to become politically active. The Republicans, in short, need to establish a "ground game" to offset the Democrats' considerable advantage in that area.
